VINHO REGIONAL ALENTEJANO

Climate: Continental Mediterranean.
Warm and dry days with large daily temperature amplitude.

Soils: Schist.

Grape Varieties: 40% Aragonez, 40% Alicante Bouschet,
10% Touriga Nacional and 10% Syrah.

Winemaking Process: Hand harvest. Total de-stemming.
Cold soaking for 3 days. Fermentation in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats at 26/27°C.

Aging: 1 year in 300L French Oak Barrels (30% new).

Chemical Analysis:

Alcohol: 14%

pH: 3,65

Total Acidity: 5,5 g/L

Reducing Sugars: 1,5 g/L

Tasting Notes: Made mainly from the typical grape varieties of the region. This wine is garnet red in colour. It shows a rich aromatic complexity with ripe fruit and spice notes. Full-bodied in the mouth with ripe tannins. It's complex and has a long aftertaste.
